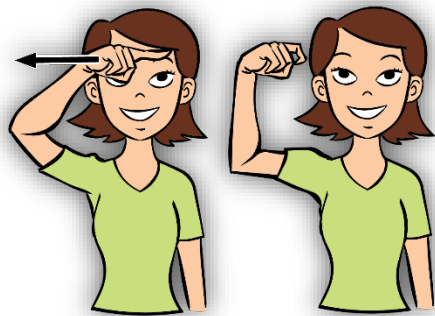

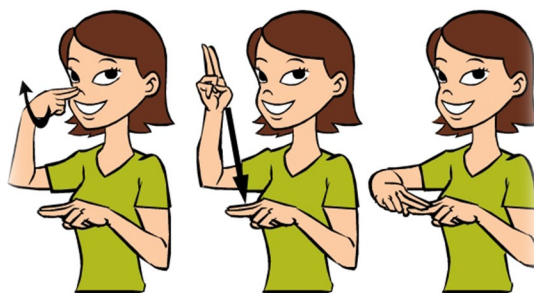
As we are concerned for the safety of everyone, especially during inclement weather, please call (989) 272-7204 to let CTS know if your participant is not going to attend program for any reason.
