- Services Consist of:
 - Case Management
 - Therapy
 - Groups
 - Link to ancillary services such as Psychiatry, Med Drop, Clubhouse, SE, etc.

Motion made by Jaime Huffman and supported by Jacob Kern to receive and file the Transition Age Youth Update. Motion Carried.

V. OTHER ITEMS OF IMPORTANCE

Sandy reported that select SWMBH and MSHN CEOs continue to meet regarding new potential RFP. A SOM Procurement Dashboard in the State of MI website notes a new PIHP RFP sometime in July/August/September. Currently assigning members of this group work on document comparison (operating agreements, Bylaws, Financials, etc.) before this RFP drops. In the past it has always been up to CMHSP CEOs to do the work

creating PIHP regions. No idea what the maps/RFP requirements will include exactly though so stay tuned.
