What's Going On?

- Medicaid is a federal-state program covering over 90 million people in the U.S.
 - Medicaid is the largest health insurance program in the country
- Federal proposals threaten to cut **\$880 billion from Medicaid** over the next decade.
- Michigan could lose up to **\$16 billion** in funding between FY25 and FY34

In MI, Medicaid Covers:

1 in 5 adults ages 19-64



2 in 5 children



3 in 5 nursing home residents



1 in 6 Medicare beneficiaries




3 in 8 people with disabilities




What is at Stake in MI?

- Reduction in eligibility for Medicaid - including Health Michigan - with 90% federal funding match
- Cuts to provider reimbursements
 - Hospitals
 - Nursing Homes
 - Ambulances
 - Primary and Specialty Outpatient Care including Behavioral health
 - Pharmacy
- Work requirements that restrict Medicaid eligibility and access to healthcare
- Possible shift to block grants or per capita caps
 - Permanent federal funding limits
