Bring lunches that do not need to be heated up when we are going on outings. We do not have access to microwaves at parks and most outings.



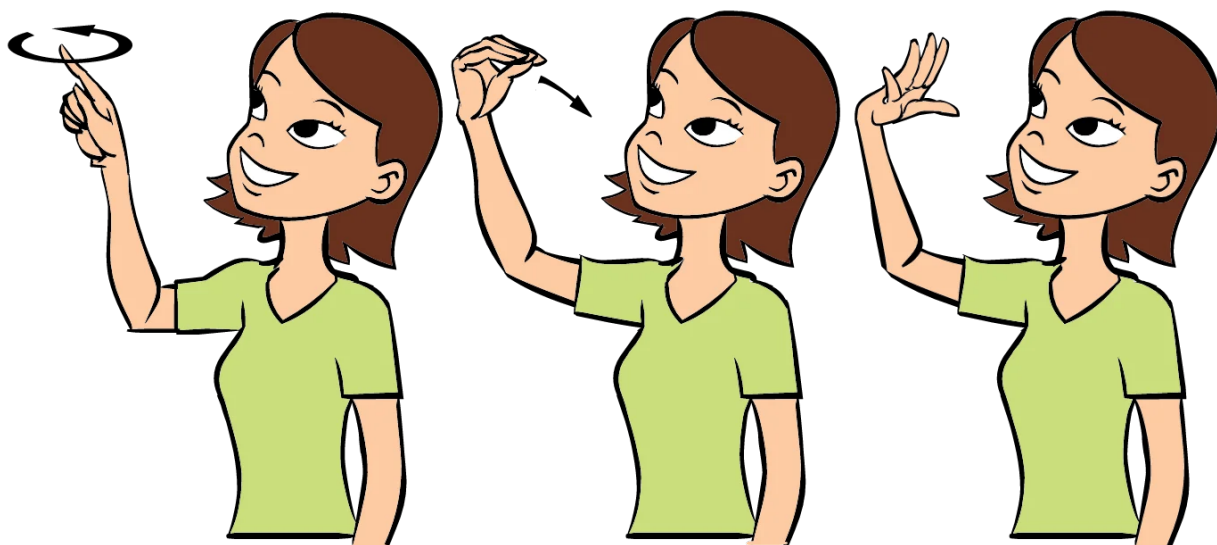

Please make sure all personal clothing items are labeled so we can make sure they return home with the correct participant.
