Please make sure your participant always has at least one change of clothing at CTS. We have some clothing on hand for emergency use and request that it be promptly returned to CTS after being used.

**For Outings: Bring lunches with a cold pack. Do not bring items that need to be heated. We do not have access to microwaves at parks and on most outings.**



As we get into the warmer season, it is very important that all participants come to program dressed appropriately. This may include extra clothing, a raincoat, or an umbrella on rainy days. If your participant is in a wheelchair, please remember that it takes some time for the van's wheelchair lift to rise and lower. During this time, your participant is sitting in the heat and sunshine to load/unload from the van. Please make sure all personal clothing items are labeled so we can make sure they return home with the correct participant.
